

AN EVALUATION OF NATIONAL LIBRARIES WEBSITES: A STUDY

Abstract: This study is an attempt to analyse the website of 37 National Libraries Website of worldwide at macro level using a five checkpoint indicator. The paper goes on to analyse the usability checkpoints, to identify the content Coverage of national library webpage, Currency, Authority, Contact detail, Easy of Navigation, on the webpage of national library. The checkpoint wise analyses show the most frequently sought after features viz. about us, contact details, copyright, services and collection, news and events, and feedback etc. For them the availability and access to required information on national library website is the most convenient and reliable source. Only five national libraries website have achieved average score for the presence of different checkpoint. From these observations the paper moves on to analyse and suggest ways to increase the visibility of the national libraries and the role libraries play in aiding the increase of visibility. The role of librarian is of utmost importance as they only can take initiative by convincing the administration about a full-fledged exclusive dynamic website where its services and resources are to be brought to the notice of all types of users besides their effective and efficient use.

Basically it aim at passing a comprehensive collection of all the document product produced in the origin of the National Library. The ruler was result Library with a collection of rare and valuable document running into few hundred thousand volumes. Two important special feature of National Library –

- The comprehensive collection of not only National outputs but also of the document published outside the countries that are about the nation.
- The responsibility of preserving this document for posterity.

National Library has special responsibility, often define in law, Within Library and Information system. These responsibilities very form country to country but are likely to include.

- The collection via legal deposit of National imprint,(both print and electronic)
- Its cataloguing and preservation.
- The provision of central services to user both directly and through the other Library and information Centre.
- The preservation and promotion of the National cultural heritage.
- Acquisition of at least a representative collection of foreign publication.
- The promotion of National cultural policy.
- Leadership in National literacy.

Data Analysis and Interpretation:

Home page is very important & it plays major role in providing web based information services to the end of users. Home page consists of what the site contains similar to contents page of book. Websites are means of publicity for organization hosting the page. The home page of National Libraries web sites have been evaluated by applying set evaluation criteria these are following.

1. Content Coverage
2. Currency
3. Authority
4. Content Detail
5. Easy of Navigation

Content Coverage:

Table 6.1 show the information about the national library include on the home page in the form of hyperlinks web analyzed during the study. The home page observed to assess the presence of hyperlinks such as welcome, History, About us, Content, Site map, FAQ, Publication, Administration, News / Events, Exhibitions, Services & Collection, Key Word Search, Help, OPAC, Copy right, Feedback etc.

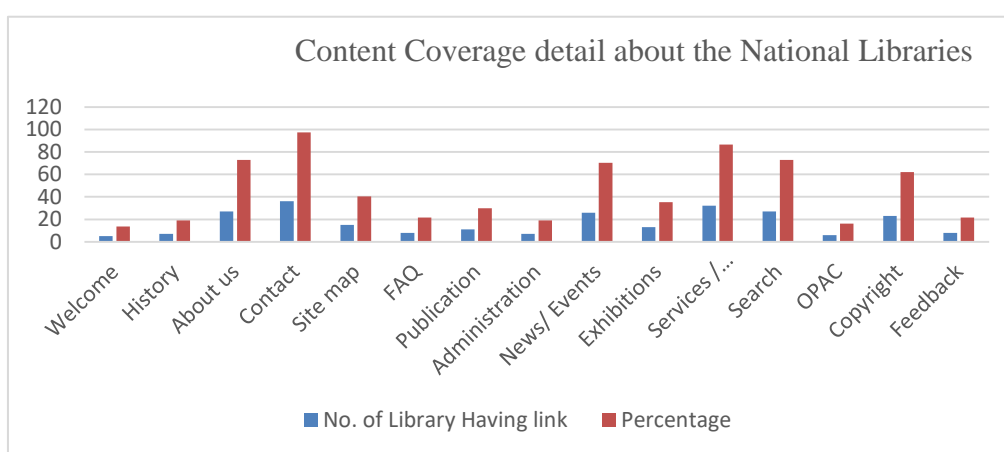

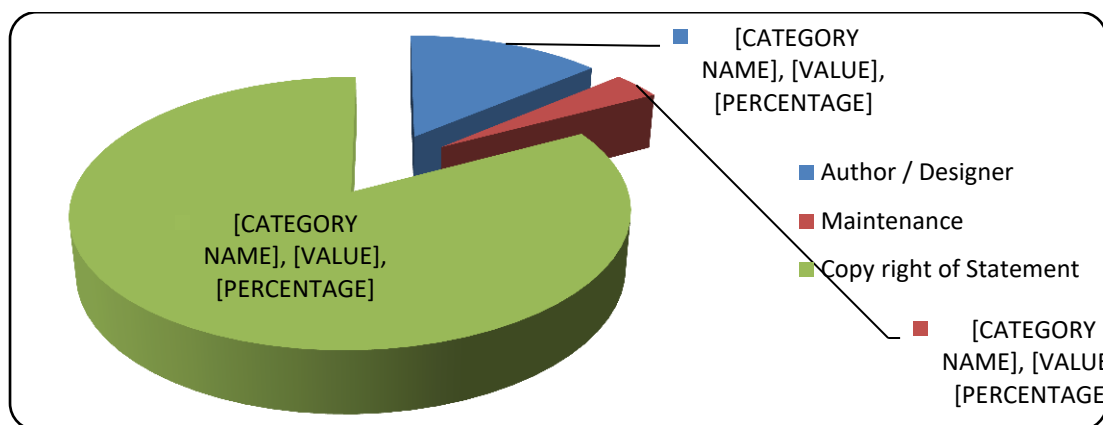

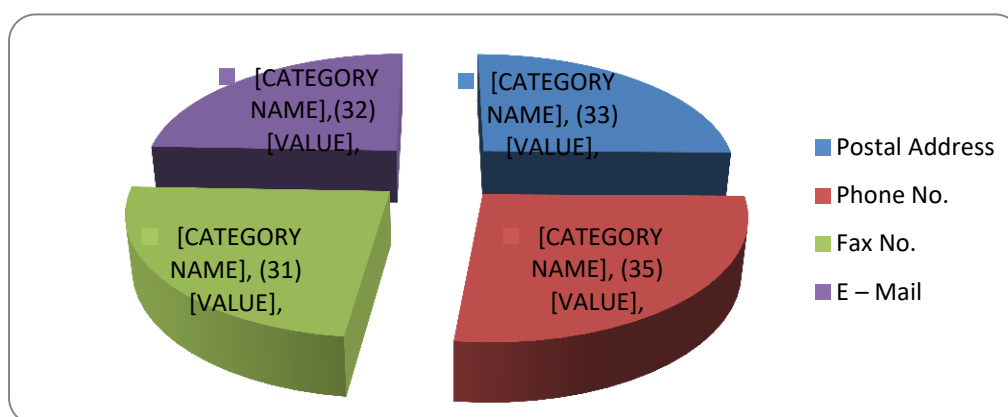

- Animation

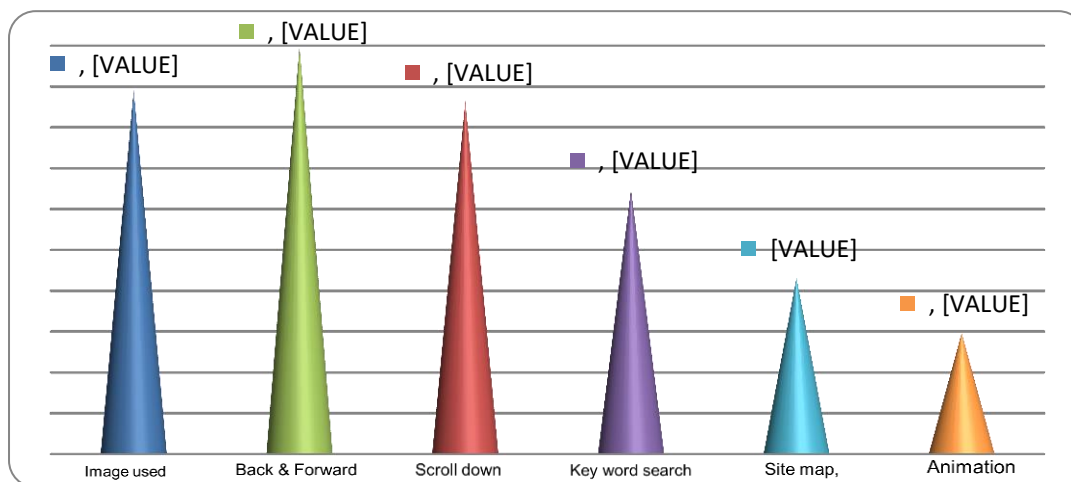

Back and forward is provided by (37) 100% having national library webpage. Scroll down is given by only (32) 86.49% web page. Key word search is provided by (24) 64.86% having national library webpage. Site Map is provided (16) 43.24 %, and animation (11) 29.73 % having national library webpage.

Conclusions :

The national libraries website/webpage were evaluated by using the criteria site access, contact detail, authority, currency, content coverage and easy of navigation. The total no. 37 national libraries were selected for the study. The conclusions drawn from the study are.

1. The authenticity of the website is decided from the statement of authority provided in the home page of national libraries, authority statement include following criteria author, designer, maintenance and copy right.
2. The home page should serve of an excellent menu page for the visitor; it should help the visitor to move quickly to what they need. The national libraries home page of the provided the criteria of the content coverage, welcome, History, About us, Content, Site map, FAQ, Publication, Administration, News / Events, Exhibitions, Services & Collection, Key Word Search, Help, OPAC, Copy right, Feedback etc.
3. Easy of navigation is the important criteria for evaluation of the website.

4. Date of the last updating of the website decides the currency of the information included in the webpage of the national libraries, also frequency should be mentioned on the home page.
5. Provision of the contact details on national libraries home pages in the form of separate contact link is commonly observed.
6. The national libraries home page should also covered other link to related website.
7. A good national libraries webpage should be cover the latest information about the library.
