- **5. Eliminate false information:** The present age is the age of information. New information is being created every day. This process is necessary to provide readers with information that changes at particular times. Revised editions of Encyclopedias and Biography are coming out. At such times, it is necessary to cancel the old literature by taking these encyclopedias, encyclopedias, and biographies. Readers may get the wrong information from this old literature. This process is necessary for readers to get real information.
- 6. Reading Material Usage: Not all materials available in the library will be useful. At that time the library staff should study which materials are used the most and which materials are not used.
