- Sufficient knowledge of ICT based technology is required for participating libraries to manage the library consortium but most library professionals and users are unfamiliar with advanced technology. That is why a training, awareness program is very necessary
- There is also a publisher's copyright issue. Sometimes publishers have provided the unwanted or irrelevant magazines in their packages to create a puzzle
- The absence of printed copies of the magazines is one of the main drawbacks in the consortium

- Solved maintenance issues
